



ACKNOWLEDGEMENT and Indemnity

I/We the undersigned, being the shipper/s / owners/s of the brachycephalic animal/s offered to Air New Zealand International Cargo under air waybill 086.....

Hereby Acknowledge:

(a) that animals belonging to brachycephalic breeds are more prone to respiratory distress and heat due to upper respiratory tract anatomical anomalies which are prevalent in these breeds. **This predisposition increases the risk of morbidity and mortality occurring during international travel.**

- (b) that the consignment has been offered to AIR NEW ZEALAND LIMITED for carriage in a cage:
- which is larger than normally required (for animals eight years and older, twice as large)
 - that contains no food
 - that contains water
 - has ventilation on all four sides.

(c) that the consignment is accompanied by a letter or certificate from a Veterinarian stating that the animal is fit to make an international flight or series of flights of the duration that it will take to reach destination.

(d) that the provisions of the Air New Zealand’s Conditions of Carriage relating to the carriage of livestock will apply to limit or exclude Air New Zealand’s liability.

(e) In consideration of Air New Zealand agreeing to carry this animal the shipper/s owner/s hereby agree to release, indemnify and protect Air New Zealand from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, costs and proceeding that may be brought against or incurred by the shipper/s owner/s as a result.
